Make Your Day is the citizenship program that you will be using while you substitute here. It is used throughout our school and is based on one rule that you will see posted in each classroom. NO ONE HAS THE RIGHT TO INTERFERE WITH.....

Implementing the program involves two procedures: 1) Points and Concerns, and 2) Steps. The students should be very helpful during the day and as the system is used. The best approach you can take upon students' entrance is to let them know what you will be expecting from them to earn full points and your hopes that every student will make their day count.

<u>Points</u>
Students earn points by doing what is expected and doing the best they can. Students may earn points during the regular class periods and points during lunch/recess and special area classes.
At the beginning of each class, remind students that they can earn full points by doing what is expected. Review what you expect, especially if anything special is occurring. Do points at these times:
