

Multiple Concerns

Count hands.
(to determine the sequence of Concerns)



First Student B states Concern

Student A responds

Student B accepts or rejects response



If Student B accepts the response and agrees with the points, the discussion is finished



If Student B rejects the response or does not agree with the points, new points are given by student B

Points are listed



Second Student B states Concern

Follow the same process



Third Student B States Concern

Follow the same process

Once all Concerns are stated:

Student A may reject all point values listed. The final point value is the median score between the highest point value and lowest point value listed.

Or

Student A is given an opportunity to accept one of the point values. Once Student A accepts a different point value, their original points are discarded. The final point value is then the median score between the remaining highest and lowest point values listed.
